



Learning Uncovered Events

What kind of partners work with us on these events?

Developed in conjunction with umbrella organisations working in the voluntary sector, previous partners have included EVOC, GCVS, DVA, Stirling Council Ethnic Minority Dept and BEMIS.

What is the objective of the event?

These events explain some of the learning support available from learndirect scotland, ILA Scotland and learndirect scotland for business. If appropriate the learning support available from the partner organisation would also be included as a workshop.

Who is the event relevant to?

This event will be relevant to the majority of voluntary organisations, as it covers learning promotion, learning provision and staff development.

What is the format of the event?

There is a very short introduction session and then a pre- booked choice of up to 7 learndirect scotland workshops, with the option for the partner to provide additional workshops. There is a closing session and a networking lunch.

Workshops

- How to put your training courses in front of thousands of individuals and businesses through our national learning opportunities database;
- How to network with and get support available from the network of branded learning centres;
- What help is available to promote learning to your service users, volunteers and staff;
- How to gain access to e learning for your service users, volunteers and staff;
- How your organisation can work in partnership with ILA Scotland to promote funding for learning to your services users, volunteers and staff;
- How to get advice and guidance about learning – everything from suitable formats and types to ways to overcome barriers to learning;
- How to develop your workforce through learning and training.

What is the role of learndirect scotland?

- To arrange and manage venue and catering booking;
- To manage delegate bookings prior to the event;
- To arrange for an electronic format leaflet about the day to be sent to the partner organisation;
- On the day to manage the workshops format, evaluations and collect details for follow up activity.

What is the expected role of the partner?

- To send learndirect scotland a copy of their logo for use on electronic literature;
- To promote out the event to their members and service users;
- To suggest appropriate local venues and catering.

How do we measure success?

We would aim to get between 30 - 40 organisations to attend an event. And we would hope to follow up with at least 50% of the organisations in one way or other over the next year.
